

AN ORDINANCE DEFINING, REGULATING AND LICENSING PERSONS CONDUCTING GARAGE SALES AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF BRECKENRIDGE HILLS, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for a person, firm or corporation to engage in the sale of merchandise (commonly known as a garage sale) from a home in a residential district without first obtaining a license therefore in compliance with the provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 2. For the purpose of this ordinance, a garage sale is defined as temporary business wherein the property owner or resident of a home within a residential district engages in the temporary business of selling and delivering wares and merchandise from the home or other building located on his property.

SECTION 3. Applicants for license under this Section, whether a person, firm, or corporation shall file a written sworn application signed by the applicant stating that all items to be sold are owned by him and not purchased or consigned for the sole purpose of this sale.

SECTION 4. A property owner in a residential district shall be entitled to apply for two (2) such licenses in a twelve (12) month period and each said license shall be good for two (2) consecutive days only.

SECTION 5. Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this Section shall upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine not to exceed one hundred dollars (\$100.00) or imprisonment not to exceed thirty (30) days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

SECTION 6. No signs shall be posted anywhere in the City advertising such sales, except that property owner may in the residential lot on which such sale is to be held, place on3e (1) sign no larger than two feet by three feet (2 ft x 3 ft) advertising such sale. Such signs shall be erected not sooner than two (2) days prior to the date of the sale, and shall be removed at the end of the last day upon which the sale is held. No signs shall be placed on any utility poles in the city.
